

LADIES AIRM IV hardcourt bike polo tournament LEXINGTON • KENTUCKY



Hardcourt bike polo is a quickly growing sport, with clubs popping up in nearly every country on the map. The women and men who play bike polo are dedicated to the advancement of the sport, maintaining the integrity and competitiveness of a serious game while supporting a cohesive community that is shared around the world, making hardcourt bike polo an increasingly important part of the cycling world.

Ladies Army is an annual all-female bike polo tournament started in 2009 in an effort to showcase female bike polo talent. Every year, Ladies Army is an anticipated event, drawing female polo players from around the world to battle it out on a central court. Previous Ladies Army tournaments have been hosted by New York City Bike Polo in 2010 and Austin Texas Polo Social Club in 2011.

Ladies Army IV and coed tournament will take place on April 27-29, 2012 at the Lexington Bike Polo Courts located at the corner of 6th and Jefferson in Coolavin Park. This tournament is predicted to attract over 30 all-female teams from cities in North America, Europe, and Asia, as well as many of their male counterparts who will compete in the coed portion play of the weekend.

Since its formation in 2007, Lexington's reputation in the bike polo community has been one of hard work, successful tournament presentation, and dedication to maintaining the sport's integrity and development. As many as 25 polo players populate Lexington's bike polo courts, which are exclusively maintained by local players with the support of Parks and Recreation. Polo players from cities around the country often visit to join in Lexington's weekly pickup games at Coolavin Park, which is located in the up-and-coming Northside of Lexington, close to many popular restaurants and bars, the Legacy Trail, and the new Bread Box, a mixed-use building that will house West Sixth Brewing, Broke Spoke Community Bike Shop, Cricket Press, and Foodchain.

Lexington Bike Polo has had several write-ups in the Herald Leader and North of Center, and bike polo demonstrations can often be seen during downtown Lexington events such as Bike Lexington, Second Sunday, and neighborhood block parties.
